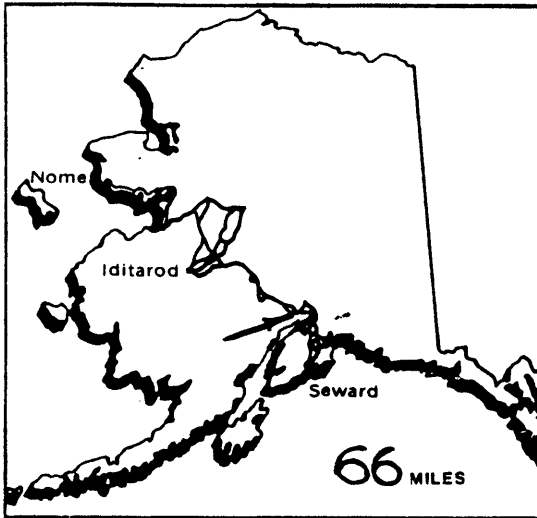

RECREATION USE (HIGH POTENTIAL)

Winter trail only, currently used by dog teams, snow mobiles and cross country skiers. Trail was brushed and marked in 1980-81 by state of Alaska (Knik to Finger Lake.) Marked trail is state's recognized historic route.

OUTDOOR RECREATION OPPORTUNITIES & RECOMMENDATIONS

RIGHT OF WAY, EASEMENT, PUBLIC ACCESS

100-1000' right of way on public lands (state) along existing marked trail.

TRAIL MARKING AND MAINTENANCE

- ① Maintain current markers, replace with NT markers as needed.
- ② Maintain winter route with volunteers yearly.

CONSTRUCTION

Trailhead construction - Knik vicinity

RESTRICTED USES

Winter use only, except as necessary for private land owners to gain access to private lands.

SPECIAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- ① Purchase 1 1/2 miles of private land Knik vicinity (B.O.R. recommendation), to provide access between road system and winter trail.
