**HISTORIC SIGNIFICANCE**

Lynch reports original structure construction in 1924, rebuilt in 1929 (assumed Cabin #1). ADP reports it was owned by the Richards Brothers in 1917 and abandoned before 1949. Cabin #2 has inscription "Built 1910, rebuilt July 5, 1918; Jim Davidson, May 6, 1917."  
 Building #1 has penciled "Ernie Mattocnie, November 2, 1938."  
 C. M. Brown reports this was one of several roadhouses constructed in 1910 on Tatina River. First proprietor was "Big John" O. Strand. Joe Vogler was proprietor during winter 1913-1914. 1917-"Richards Brothers," in 1920-Joe Blachell. In 1918 or 1921, Robert R. Jones and W. James Davidson assumed ownership. In 1923 Jones and Davidson contracted with -ARC to clear right-of-way through Dalzell Canyon. Davidson and Einar Carlson operated in 1923-24. In ~~May~~ <sup>June</sup> 1924 it was destroyed by fire.
