STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

Foundation remains of several structures remain at the old settlement
site of Long. Other structures in the area have fallen to
~~active~~ mining activities (part).

Gold Mining activities began in the Long area in the fall of 1911
and continues today by the present owner. Long developed as
a major stop over approximately half way between Ruby and
Poorman. The Wild Goose Roadhouse operated at Long up until the
1930's when it burnt. It was a sizable 2 story road home/hotel
Long, and dining and was ~~known~~ ^{known} for the dances and good times that
were experienced there by the local miners - THE LAST OPERATOR AT
THE WILD GOOSE WAS A MAN NAMED WALKER
