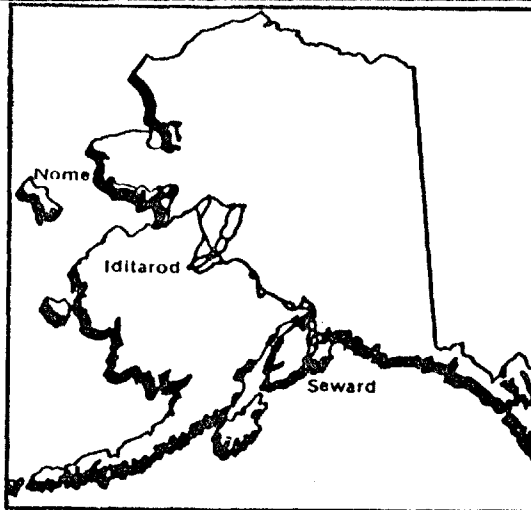

Statement & Significance

TYO-011 consists of 10-15 cache pits ranging in size from 1x1 m. to 2x2 m. This site sits on a low terrace on the east bank of Fish Lake Creek, 1/2 miles from its mouth. Cracked rock, bone and bark have been recovered from TYO-011. It is likely a TANAINA fishing camp.
