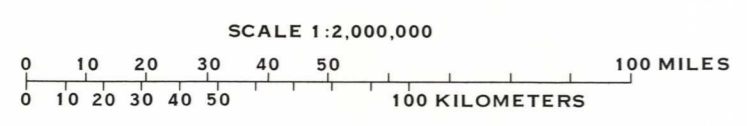


BASE FROM U.S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY
