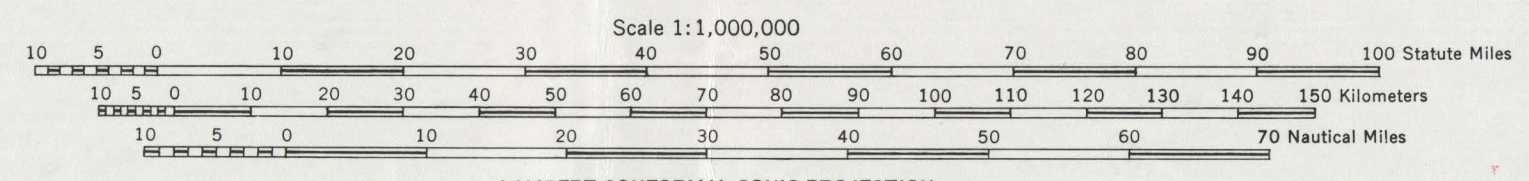
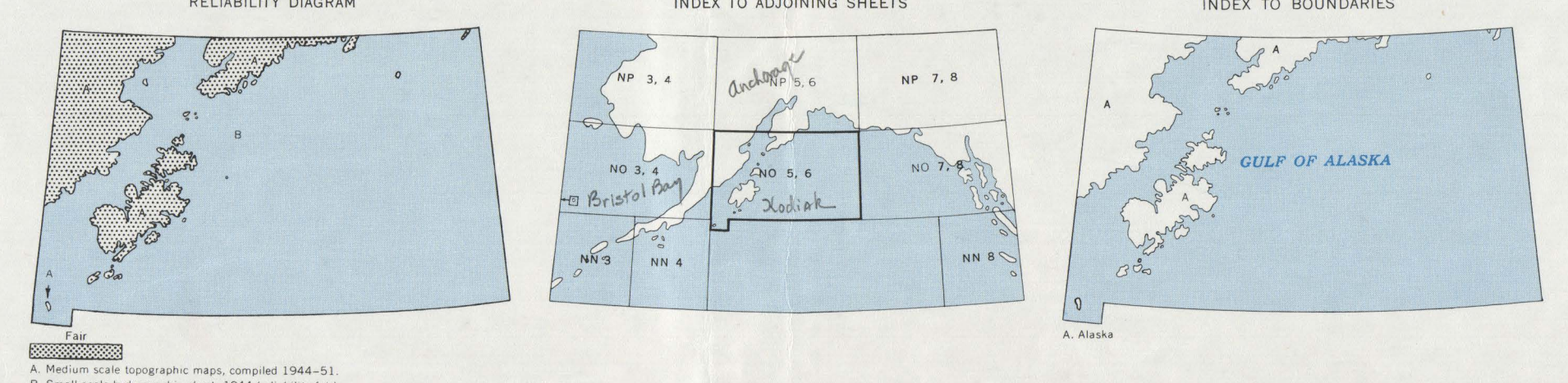

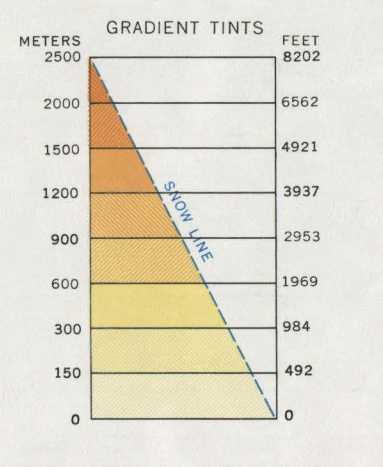
This map follows the sheet lines and numbering system of the International Map of the World, but does not conform to the specifications for that series in all respects.
