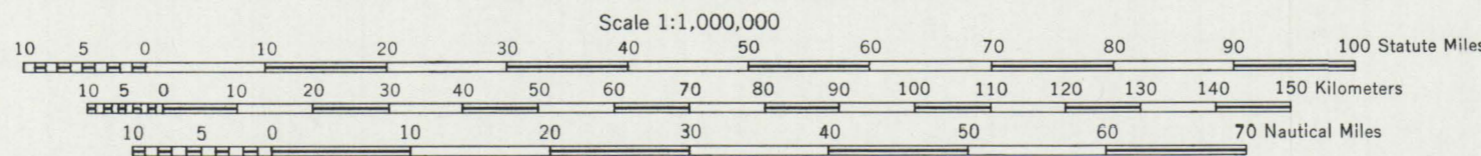

ALL HEIGHTS ARE REFERRED TO MEAN SEA LEVEL

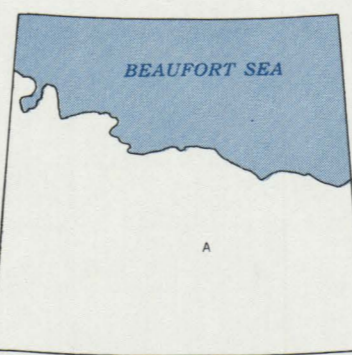
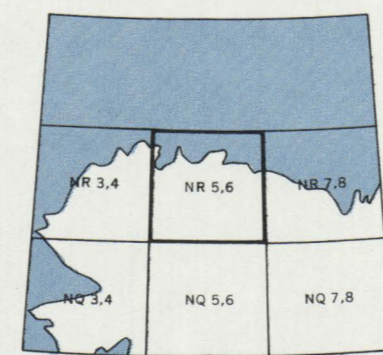
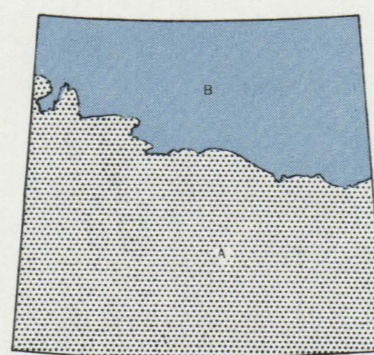
