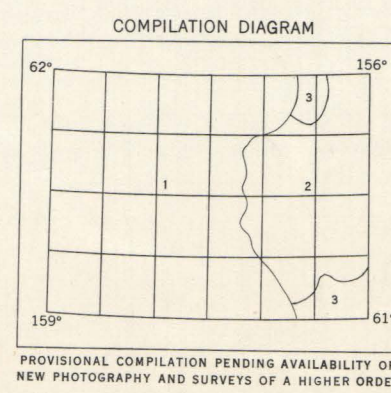
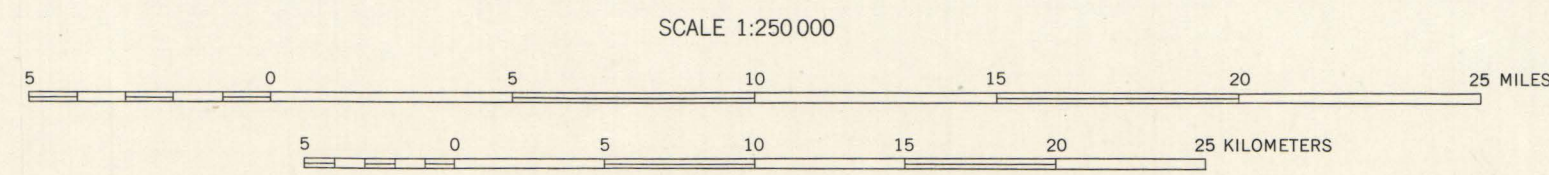


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UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION, ZONE 4

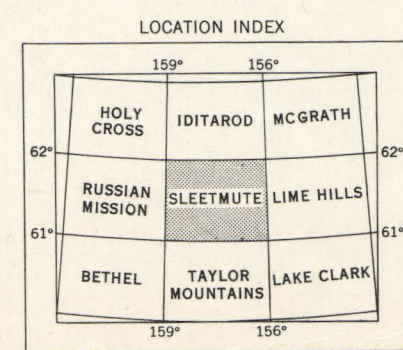


- 1 TOPOGRAPHY FROM ALASKA MAP 55 TRANSFERRED AND ADJUSTED TO TRIMETROGON BASE
