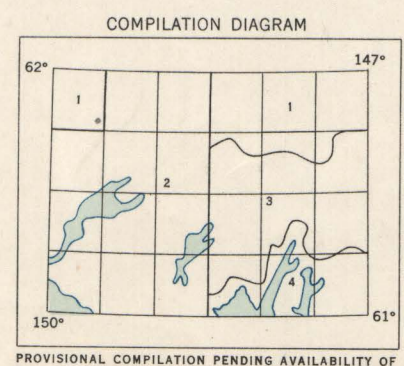
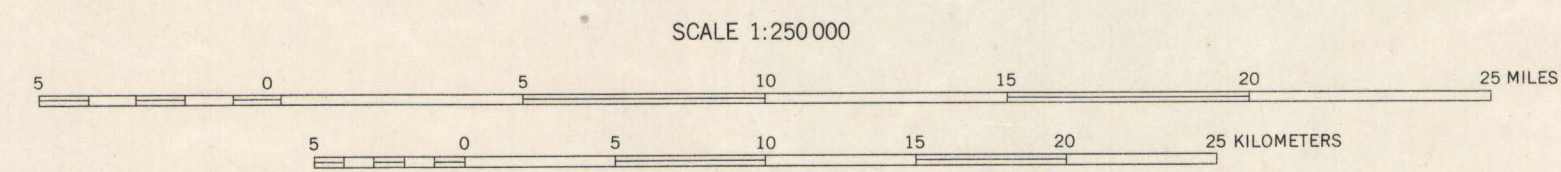

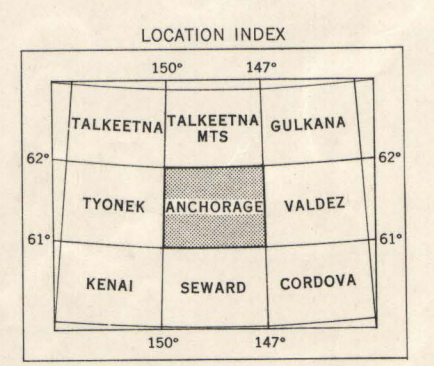


1. TOPOGRAPHY FROM ALASKA MAP 24 TRANSFERRED AND ADJUSTED TO TRIMETROGON BASE
