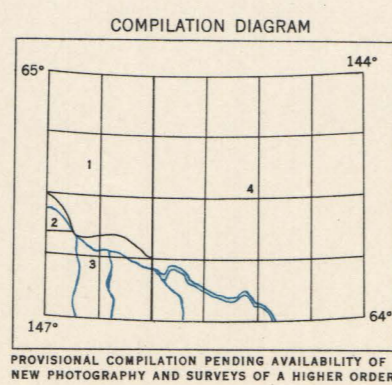
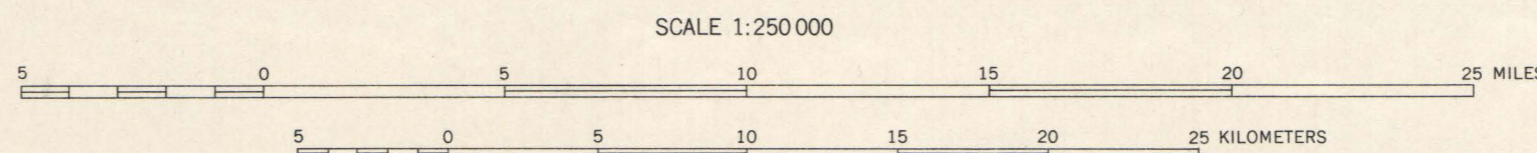

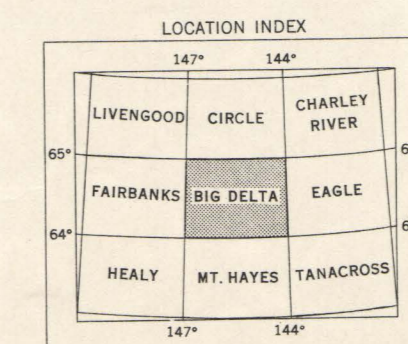


1. TOPOGRAPHY FROM ALASKA MAP 39 ADJUSTED TO TRIMETROGON BASE.
