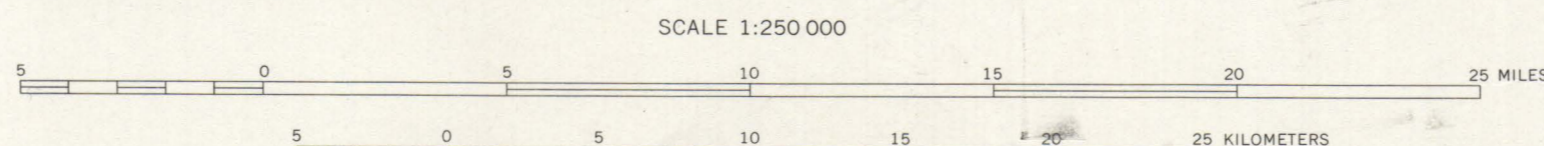

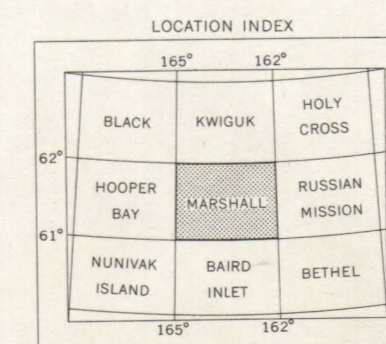
UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION, 1927 NORTH AMERICAN DATUM
