

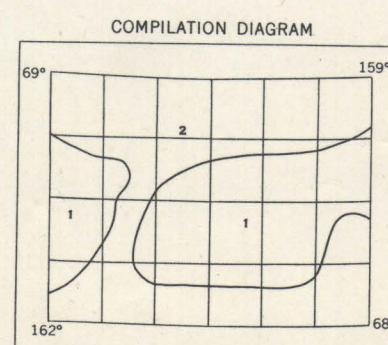

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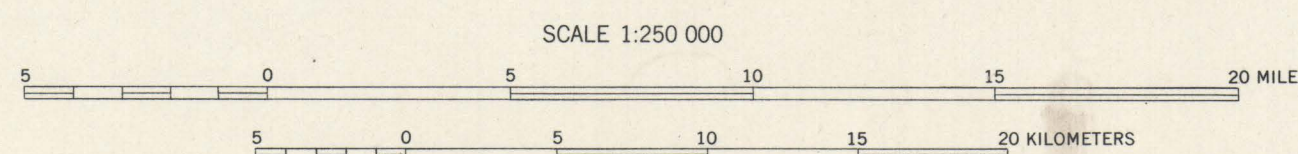

2. TOPOGRAPHY FROM USGS MAP #7 ADJUSTED TO TRIMETROGN BASE

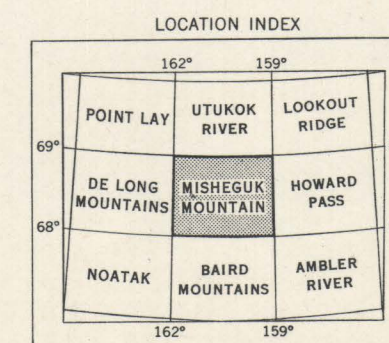
