JOINT U.S., SOVIET VESSEL OPERATIONS REPORT

05 MAY 89

CGC RUSH (378 FT HIGH ENDURANCE CUTTER PACIFIC AREA)

In vicinity of Smith Island. Performing shoreline clean up monitoring and cleanup vessel status surveys with A/C and ship's boats.

CGC SWEETBRIER (180 FT OCEANGOING BUOY TENDER DISTRICT 17)

In vicinity of Seal Island performing shoreline clean up monitoring.

A.C.O.E. YAQUINA (DREDGE)

In Wildcat Cove conducting recovery OPS.

NOAA'S RAINIER (245 FT NOAA RESEARCH VESSEL)

En route to Cordova for a well earned patrol break. Will return to NOAA's operational control 0800 8MAY89.

USS JUNEAU (569 FT "AUSTIN" CLASS AMPHIBIOUS TRANSPORT DOCK)

Anchored north of Smith Island. USS JUNEAU reports that 45 bbls were washed from the beach and recovered by skimmers yesterday. They are continuing with beach cleaning efforts on Smith Island.

USS FORT MCHENRY (609 FT "WHIDBEY IS." CLASS DOCK LANDING SHIP)

Inbound to port of Valdez to moor at City Pier at approximately 1700 tonight. While in port USS FORT MCHENRY will take aboard equipment and over 350 civilian workers prior to departing to join USS JUNEAU in Prince William Sound.

CGC STORIS (230 FT MEDIUM ENDURANCE CUTTER DISTRICT 17)

In Wildcat Cove coordinating oil recovery operations in Chugach Islands, Nuka Bay, Nuka Passage and Pye Islands.

CGC YOCONA (MEDIUM ENDURANCE CUTTER PACIFIC AREA)

In Shelikof Strait in the vicinity of Karluk serving as command vessel for offshore skimming operations in Shelikof Strait.

A.C.O.E. ESSAYONS (DREDGE)

Anchored in NE Sutwick Is. awaiting overflight information. Future plans are to continue oil recovery OPS in Shelikof Strait with support of F/V's as directed by CGC YOCONA.

CGC PLANETREE (180 FT OCEANGOING BUOY TENDER DISTRICT 17)

In Amalik Bay waiting to assist in deployment of 1000 meters 84-inch boom.

VAYDAGUBSKY (425 FT SOVIET ICEBREAKING CLASS 3 SKIMMER)

In Seward for reprovisioning. Future plans are to continue oil recovery OPS in Shelikof Strait with support of F/V's as directed by CGC YOCONA. M/V VAYDAGUBSKY reports recovering 376 bbls of oil yesterday in Shelikof Strait west of Uyak Island.
