HISTORIC SIGNIFICANCE

Turnagain District Headquarters site for AEC, 1918.
 1916-1917, dock and warehouse were built.
 1920, station house, shed, bunkhouse and liquor store at the site.
 As early as 1910, the Alaska Northern had an advance survey crew camping at this location.

SITE IDENTIFICATION / CONDITION / INTEGRITY

Store building at Indian is a construction crew bunkhouse that was moved from the Rainbow Camp during the 1950s.
 Trail is evident just north of the site. Johnson Trail ran through the site.
