Beginning of Iditarod Trail construction. <i>Orth; local name for a flag stop reported in 1912 by ARR Commissioner</i> SEW-102 - Roadhouse was built by Captain Northway with kennels for 40 dogs. Nellie Lawing owned in late 1910s. 1914 AEC map shows a cluster of buildings near the creek.
